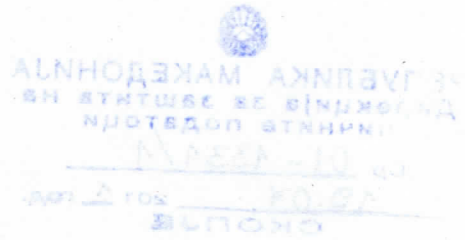

**DECLARATION ON FURTHER COOPERATION
BETWEEN

THE BERLIN COMMISSIONER FOR
DATA PROTECTION AND FREEDOM OF INFORMATION**

Berlin, 12 July 2011

The Directorate for Personal Data Protection of the Republic of Macedonia and the Berlin Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information wish to make a mutual statement affirming their present cooperation and their willingness to continue with the mutual cooperation.

This cooperation is to improve the exchange of the best practice experiences and knowledge among the experts of both institutions relating to the following areas:

- Legislative development and cooperation in international acting with a view of reaching a harmonized solution of various problems
- Exchange of experience in the field of telecommunications
- Projects funded by the European Union


Both institutions are aware of the unavoidable need to increase cooperation between data protection authorities with a view to the establishment of a uniform application of data protection legislation existing in different countries.
